#### 1. NOTES FOR REGISTRATION:

a) If you enter with AP credits, you may be able to move up a semester on the [sample schedule](#). The earlier you can take Fin 221 and Fin 300, the better prepared you are. If you can take Fin 221 as a first semester sophomore and Fin 300 as a second semester sophomore, you are in much better shape for internships. And we definitely recommend taking Fin 300 before studying abroad.

b) In the registration system, you are coded as either an Accy or a Finance major, not both. Only Finance majors (and other degree programs that require FIN courses) have priority for registration in Fin 300. If you are coded as Accy, you will not have priority. Seats have been set aside for Finance majors in Accy 301 and 302.

#### 3. WE WILL BE ENFORCING PREREQUISITES:

- For FIN 221, you must have credit or concurrent registration in Accy 202 and Econ 203.
- For FIN 300, you must have completed FIN 221.
- For FIN 311, 321, 412, 418, 419, 422, 423, 451, 461, and 490 you must have completed FIN 300
- For FIN 418, 422 and 451, you must also have completed Fin 321. [For Fin 419 you must have completed Fin 311.](#)
- IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THE PREREQUISITE, YOU WILL BE DROPPED FROM THE COURSE.
